# **NOTICE to all Frontenac Islands Residents**

As a result of the changes occurring under

Ontario Regulation- (O. Reg. 391/21)

The responsibility of recycling and collecting household materials will be transferred to a single operator across the Province of Ontario.

2025 is the transitional year for the Frontenac Islands.

#### As of July 1, 2025, there are a few key things you need to know going forward:

- Follow the directions of the depot staff upon arrival. You will notice some
  recycling streams will be merged. An example of this is anything that is fibre
  based such as cardboard and paper, will all go into one bin. You must flatten
  down your cardboard before it arrives at the depot.
- All containers such as plastic food containers, plastic jugs, cans, glass etc. will go
  into another bin.
- Non-Household items such as metal and electronics will remain the same at this
  point.
- As a resident you will not notice changes to the items you bring to the depot, but you will notice changes to the collection process.
- The new direction of Recycling will fall to the provincially appointed agency.
- The transition begins July 1, 2025, and there will be further directions coming as the transition progresses.
